Airlie 7

Airlie's 7 is like a gathering of great friends. Bring them together, let their best qualities shine and celebrate the mix. This wine evolved by blending seven delicious Willamette Valley white varietals; showing off their **vibrancy**, appreciating their **approachability** and **experiencing** their complexity. A touch of sweetness with great structure creates this **standout gem**. A food-friendly wine or a stand alone

The Other

One is immediately struck by the vibrant color of this wine. The aromas of apples, pears and peaches are complemented by the subtle spice and oak notes. Upon the first taste on the palate, a wave of green apple, ripe pears and peaches with a hint of oak that lead to a long totally seductive finish.

Stephen Vincent Crimson

As its name implies, this Crimson has a deep, dark red color. Crimson is produced from a blend of 75% Syrah and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon grapes from the Sonoma and Central Coast growing regions of California. Crimson is a very complex wine made in the Rhone style. This very rich wine has beautiful ripe plum and blackberry flavor, accented with hints of toasty French oak, and cassis. Deep dark crimson color, with lots of black fruit in the nose. Soft tannins round out rich flavors of licorice, blackberries and cinnamon. Food suggestions: Beef, lamb, duck and pasta.

Castel del Remei

89 points Robert Parker: "One of the great values in the marketplace!" Gotim Bru is a blend of 65% Tempranillo, 20% Merlot, and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon aged 11 months in one-year old French and American oak barrels. This is a custom cuvee selected and blended by importer Eric Solomon (the European Cellars name will be on the back label). Showing a dense plum/ruby color and it is accompanied by aromas of melted chocolate, roasted coffee beans, and plenty of sweet black cherry fruit. This dense, corpulent, earthy red possesses rich fruit, medium body, not a great deal of complexity, but a mouthfilling generosity. It will provide a lot of pleasure over the next 2-3 years. (4/04)" I agree! Big rich and easy to drink, this red from Catalunya has plenty of ripe black currant fruit with a smattering of oak on the finish. Make this red your "house wine"---

Rabid Red

With a deep, positively inky color with purple/garnet tones, the 2004 Rabid Red offers broad, ripe aromas of baked cherry, clove spice, and dark chocolate. On the palate, it is full-blooded and resonant without harshness. Flavors range from ripe cherry and blueberry to coffee bean, cocoa, cedar and anise. This wine is equally at home with home barbeque fare, as well as with more elaborate preparations of red meat, poultry, and game.

It is the largest facility in Italy dedicated exclusively to producing world-class sparkling wines.

Trivento Chardonnay

Combines distinctive varietal character with judicious oak aging to deliver rich banana and crisp apple flavors complemented by toast notes. After fermentation, the wine is aged in French oak for two months. Well suited for seafood and white meats.

Trivento Syrah

An alluring nose of violets and cassis. Intense red in color, the wine is smooth and velvety on the palate with supple tannins. It offers rich fruit flavors complemented by spice notes. Aged in American and French oak for 5 to 7 months, it is perfect for braised beef or lamb as well as for Mediterranean fare.

Joe Blow Red

The red wine is a blend of five varieties - syrah, merlot, petite sirah, zinfandel and cabernet sauvignon. Joe Blow red has a fair amount of complexity for the price, with aromas and tastes of blueberry, black cherry, tobacco and spice. It will match with a variety of quick-fix meals, from pizza and pasta to burgers and chicken on the grill. Try chilling it for 20 minutes to make it more refreshing in the warm weather

Esser Pinot Noir

Delicate floral aromas give way to lush flavors of plum and cherry in this delicious 2005 Pinot Noir. On the palate, rounded tannins support a long polished finish. A perfect match with roasted meat dishes, hearty pastas and cheese.
