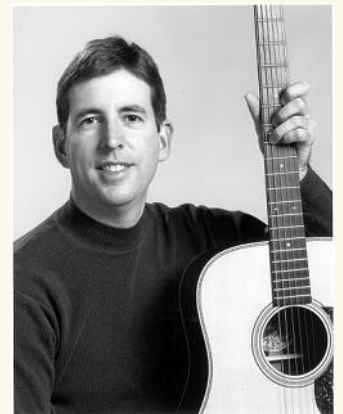

Classic Cigarzin blend of exotic fruit and spice aromas. Pomegranate, rhubarb, red cherries and cream flavors intermingle in a rich, concentrated style with spicy notes. Structured with a bright fruit tartness despite being big, rich, and mouthfilling throughout.

The Novelist

In the nose this wine shows aromas of melon and fresh finely chopped Italian parsley, centered flavors of Pear and baking spices that lead into crisp layers of citrus with the emphasis on Indian River grapefruit.



Pinot Grigio

Most awarded Pinot Grigio
Top 100 wines of 2006:San Francisco Chronicle
Aromas of citrus, kiwi, melon, minerals and honey carry into the mouth adding to the fresh, clean, vibrant fruit with a bright, refreshing center. This is a medium-bodied dry wine with a clean finish.

Syrah

Minerals, black fruits, red meat and spice on the nose. Big ripe deep fruit notes on entry. Substantially rich and concentrated with an exotic streak in the middle. Focused and intense with elements of currant, rhubarb and elements of other black fruits. Very reminiscent of a Chateauneuf-Du-Pape

Chardonnay

Medium bodied and dry. Floral and citrus notes in the nose, followed in the mouth by green apple, citrus flavors and mineral notes. Very French Chablis-like in style and balance.

The Frank

Black fruit, clove, red currant, all spice and vanilla in the nose. Youthful and intense with white pepper, red cherry and soft mineral overtones that carry through the mouth into a long finish. This full-bodied wine has long, ripe tannis, with good structure and is excellently balanced. It should age well for the next 10-12 years.

Champalou Vouvray

A very nice Vouvray. Pineapple on the nose and palate. Good acidity and minerality keeps it interesting. Very nice with a Tilapia. Subtle nose of fresh green apple and faint citrus. On the palate, it's squeaky clean, with refreshing acidity and ultra-pure granny smith apple notes. A delicious white. Surprised it does not say "Sec" on the label, as it is, in fact,

NORA

Good albarino, and Nora is one, has stone-fruit sweetness, apple sharpness and a little citrus edge, as crisp as a riesling, plus flowery perfume and round, smooth texture. Pale straw. Aromas: Peach, citrus, and hints of bitter orange and ginger. The mouthfeel is medium-bodied, round, juicy then dry. The Georgia peach and tart citrus flavors finish like a fresh fruit cobbler, but not at all sweet.

Angeline Pinot Noir

Joe Breckenridge Friday Night 7:30 -11:00



Joe has worked as a touring and studio musician around the south for over 35 years with artists that have included: Jimmy Hall, Bo Diddley, Lou Christy, The Shangri-Las, Marilee Rush, Scott Boyer, Topper Price, to name a few. Joe sings as well as playing many instruments, but mostly "acoustic, and electric guitars", "electric bass", "stand up bass", and "harmonica".

Our Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is produced from fruit that abounds with intense fruit and rich aromas. By "cold soaking" the crushed grapes and fermenting at moderate temperatures, bright fruit flavors are extracted from the grape, without harsh tannins. This Pinot Noir is a brilliant, deep ruby color with delicate aromas of raspberry, strawberry and a soft whisper of vanilla. Bright flavors of ripe raspberries and strawberries, layered with subtle nuances of vanilla oak lead to a rich, full fruit finish.

NAPA Cellars Cabernet

GOLD MEDAL, 2007 WEST COAST WINE COMP. Impressive from start to finish, the classy '04 Napa Cellars delivers excellent black fruit flavors with a hint of sweet oak; nicely textured; fine finish. Nice chocolate, blackberry and dark cherry nose with a little tobacco thrown in. The big fruit flavors blend together nicely and follows with soft tannins.

Writers Block Zinfandel

Deep candy apple red, translucent. Aromas: Raspberry, black cherry, coffee, vanilla, cocoa and baking spice. The body is light-to-medium and there's a sense of front-palate sweetness, but dry elsewhere. Without going overboard, a range of red berry, citrus rind, white pepper and cinnamon spice flavors come together nicely and finish warmly and dusty.
