Fantinel Prosecco - 100% Prosecco grown in the Frulli region. This prosecco has a beautiful straw yellow color accompanied by a fruit bouquet with hints of golden apples. It has a great aromatic taste which fills the mouth with flavors of both fruit and minerality.

Esperanza Verdejo/Viura'06: Made from equal parts of two very important indigenous Spanish varietals: Verdejo and Viura. This lively white is bright and crisp with refreshing acidity and notes of tree fruits.

Airlie 7: A blend of seven varietals (Muller Thurgau, Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Pinot blanc, Chardonnay, Pinot gris, and Muscat Ottonel) from the Willamette Valley.

Approachable enough for easy sipping yet offering layers of flavor that are sure to intrigue the seasoned wine drinker.

Cruz de Piedra Garnacha '05: 100% Grenache coming from very old vines (60 years old +) located in the Calatayud region of Spain. A lush, balanced wine that shows dark berry flavors and boasts a long finish.

Zumaya Tempranillo '05: Made from 100% Tempranillo in the Ribera Del Duero region of Spain, this soft, delicious wine offers a mouthful of black fruit with the slightest nuance of oak. Juicy enough to drink by itself but with enough structure to pair with many dishes.

Rudi Wiest Rhine River Riesling: This beautiful Riesling from the Rhine River Valley of Germany is clean, bright, flavorful, rich and balanced. It shows apricot and peach on the nose, fine fruit on the palate and excellent supporting acidity.
